Shropshire Cat Rescue 's policy is to give shelter and veterinary aid to stray and homeless cats when manpower and finances permit and find them new, safe and caring homes. However, we are often asked to take in elderly cats and for these cats it can be a long, long if not everlasting wait for a home.

Through the support of volunteers and supporters, Shropshire Cat Rescue has created a tranquil environment for our elderly residents to retire to. If a home is found—wonderful; if not, their needs will be met for the remainder of their lives in a large garden area with six, cosy, heated cottages—Lilac, Bluebell, Rose, Ivy, Buttercup and Peach Tree and one large heated summer house.

A bed of catnip; a water feature; wild garden to attract insects; ornamental grasses to rustle and play with; places to climb; places to hide; freedom to choose which cottage they want to sleep in—we hope we've created an elderly cat's haven.
